# Washington PrEP DAP



## Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis Drug Assistance Program

The Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis Drug Assistance Program (PrEP DAP) is offered through the Washington State Department of Health (DOH). It helps people in Washington, who are interested in accessing PrEP and need financial assistance paying for all or part of generic PrEP medication and PrEP related healthcare services.



If you need assistance, contact a Prevention Service Navigation Partner or DOH PrEP DAP eligibility staff.

## What is PrEP?

Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) is a highly effective medication prescribed by a provider that can prevent HIV infection when taken as directed. It has been shown to reduce the risk of HIV-1 infection through sex or injection drug use.

PrEP does not protect against other sexually transmitted infections or pregnancy, so condoms and other prevention methods may be recommended.

### Should I take PrEP?



If you and your provider feel like PrEP is a good option for you, then **YES**.

## What is PrEP DAP?

PrEP DAP may be able to pay the enrollees portion of most PrEP related medical visits, lab tests and medications as long as:

- The enrollee is eligible for PrEP DAP on the date they are seen by their provider.
- The enrollee is seen by a PrEP DAP contracted medical provider.
- The enrollee was seen for an allowed service.
- The enrollee goes to a PrEP DAP contracted pharmacy.
- The enrollee is prescribed the medication(s)\* that are on our approved list.

## Am I Eligible for PrEP DAP

To be eligible for PrEP DAP, you must:

- ~ Test negative for HIV
- ~ Live in Washington State
