Leaving a resident's room

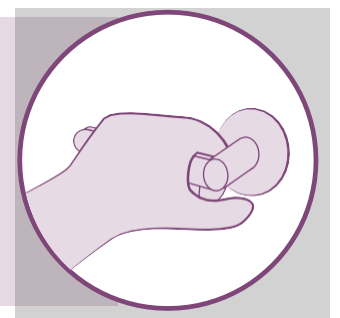
After...



Touching a resident



Contact with body fluids or helping with toileting



Touching surfaces or equipment in a resident's environment



Glove removal



Soap and Water or Hand Sanitizer?



Alcohol based hand sanitizer is:

- More effective at killing germs
- Less drying
- Easier to use during patient care

Clean hands with soap and water:

- After caring for a resident with **C. diff.**
- When hands are visibly dirty
- Before eating
- After using the restroom
